The School will undergo a comprehensive evaluation visit September 21-24 and October 19-21, 2009, by a team representing The Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The visiting team will review the institution's ongoing ability to meet the Commission's Criteria for Accreditation.
